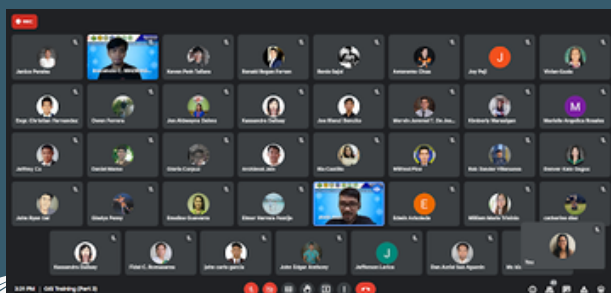


This training is the 1st part of the GIS training session that will be conducted under GADC which aims to capacitate researchers in the field of GIS.
