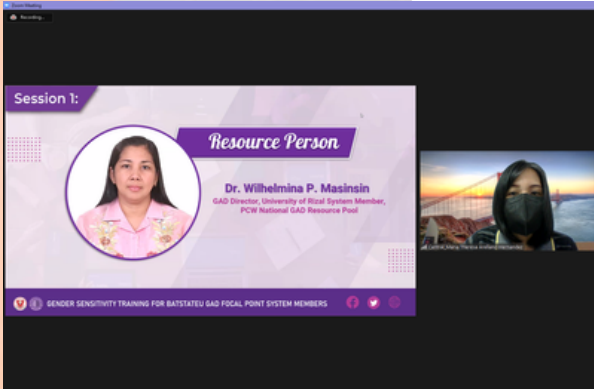
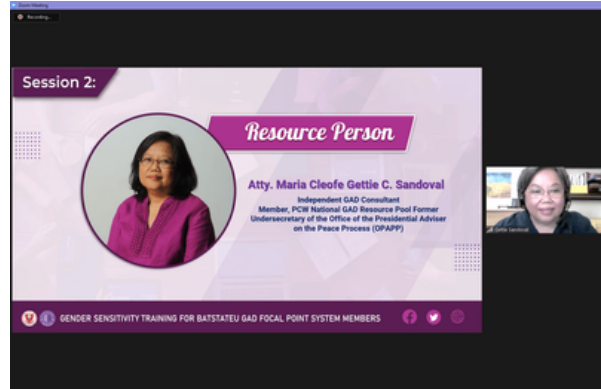


Gender Sensitivity Training for GAD Focal Point System Member

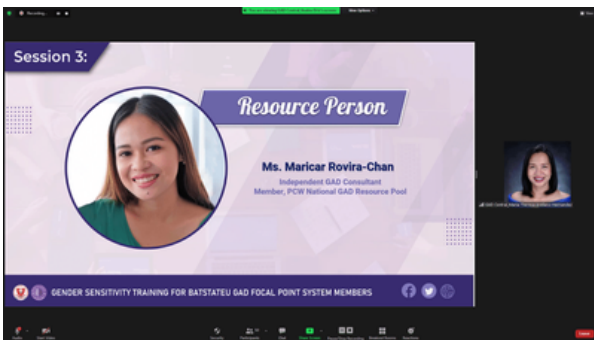

July 27 | **Session 1:** Introduction to Gender and Development Understanding the Concept of Gender



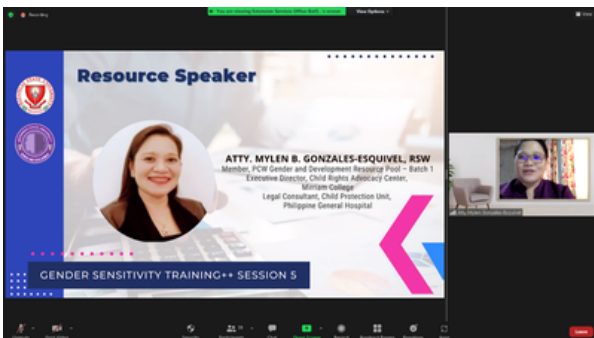
Aug 4-5 | **Session 2:** Laws and Policies on Women's Rights and Gender Equality



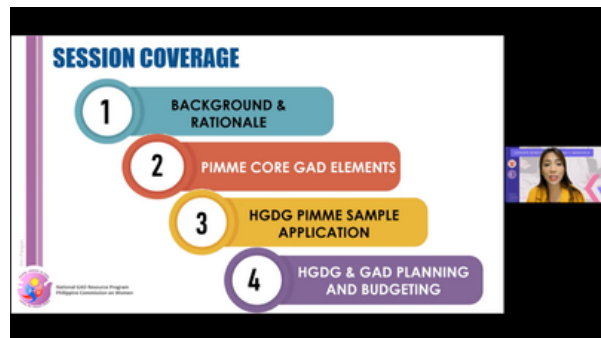
Aug 23-25, and 31 | **Session 3:** Introduction to Gender Mainstreaming and Enhanced Gender Mainstreaming Evaluation Framework
