The Gender and Development Advocacies Office

The Gender and Development Advocacies Office supports Batangas State University's vision, mission and strategic goals, as embodied in its Strategic Plan. It recognizes the various GAD commitments of the University under various gender-related laws and policies, which include, but are not limited to, the Philippine Plan for Gender-Responsive Development Plan (1995-2025), Women in Development and Nation Building Act (Republic Act No. 7192), Anti Sexual Harassment Act of 1995 (Republic Act No. 7877), Anti-Violence Against Women and their Children Act of 2004 (Republic Act No. 9262) and the Magna Carta of Women (Republic Act No. 9710), Gender and Development Accord of Philippine Higher Education Institutions, and CHED Memorandum Order No. 1, Series of 2015 (Establishing the Policies and Guidelines on Gender and Development in the Commission on Higher Education and Higher Education Institutions).

It leads in the planning and implementation, monitoring and evaluation of University programs, projects and activities which are integrated with the gender perspective. The gender perspective is mainstreamed through four (4) entry points, namely: policy, people, enabling mechanisms, and programs, projects and activities. The gender perspective is integrated in the design and implementation of University plans and programs to carry out its mandates, specifically with regards to its functions of instruction, research and extension. The goal is to make gender equality a fundamental value in development and institutional practice.

In order to ensure that the University carries out its mandates with emphasis on the attainment of SDG 5 - Gender Equality, it is guided by the annual GAD Plan and Budget, which comprises the actions it needs to take to address client- and organization-focused gender issues.

Through the Gender and Development Advocacies Office, it has organized and conducted a total of 30 mentoring programs for students. These mentoring programs focused on gender sensitivity and advocacies. A total of 20258 students, with 7019 males and 13239 females benefitted. The table that follows presents the details of the mentoring and training programs implemented for the students.
