The Republic Act 9045 and Republic Act 10931, also known as the Universal Access to Tertiary Quality Education Act, aims to promote the right of all Filipino students to accessible quality education. Section 18 of RA 9045 specifically stipulated that the University shall provide scholarship program and other affirmative action programs to assist poor but deserving students to qualify for admission to the University. Further, one of the objectives of the Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act is to give priority to students who are academically able and who come from poor families.

Relative thereto, you are hereby directed to promote these mandates in the conduct of career guidance to various secondary schools and in the conduct of evaluation of application for college admission.

The Director for Student Affairs and Services shall ensure that proper assistance is given to poor but deserving students who wish to be admitted to the University.
