

Foreign Students per Country of Origin Data Report

The university values diversity and fosters a welcoming environment for students from different cultural backgrounds. It actively promotes cross-cultural exchange and understanding among the student body. Foreign students enrolled at the university are predominantly from African and Asian countries. Specifically, 78% of the students hail from various African nations, while the remaining 22% originate from different Asian countries. As to the gender distribution, the student body consists of 65% male and 35% female. Moreover, a significant majority of 96% of these foreign students come from countries classified as low to lower-middle income economies.
