"Bantay Kalusugan and Public Health for All"

September 30, 2022

The College of Nursing and Allied Health Sciences faculty extensionists conducted a quarterly monitoring of the recently conducted extension projects Bantay Kalusugan and Public Health for All, wherein they interviewed the Sama-Bajau beneficiaries in Sitio Bajauan, Brgy. Malitam, Batangas City, regarding their learnings after their trainings on WASH, family planning, first aid and integrated management of childhood illnesses.

Afterwards, they have implemented the first phase of the Adopt-a-SAM/MAM Feeding Program among moderately and severely malnourished children in Brgy. Wawa, Batangas City. They have also initiated nutritional assessment among the beneficiaries wherein the faculty extensionists measured the mid-upper arm circumference of the children. This project will was implemented until December 2022, with the goal of assisting these children to have healthy nutritional status












