To kick-off the Innovation Month celebrations in the university, the Center for Technopreneurship and Innovation in partnership with the Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc. and Batangas Federation of Multipurpose Cooperative (BAFEMPCO) held the ceremonial MoA Signing and Awarding of Start-up Support last September 1, 2022 at 5F Function Hall of STEER Hub Bldg. Batangas State University - Alangilan Campus.
