Pablo Borbon campus has a 5-storey University Wellness Center Building with an area of 456 sqm. It houses the Health Services/Infirmary, College of Medicine, Sports Development Center, and ACTION Center. It is also where the nursery/daycare station will be located on the second floor.

The establishment of the nursery/daycare station has already been in the works since it was included as part of the 2017 GAD Plan and Budget of the University. With the implementation of the Land Use Development and Infrastructure Plan (LUDIP), this will respond to the needs of both employees and students who need access to said facility to enable them to attend to their work and university courses, respectively. This addresses the gender concern of working mothers and student mothers in the University with inadequate child care arrangements.
