




Highlight Indicators

- In 2022, the University produced 0.378 metric tons of food waste throughout its campuses. The measurement of this food waste was conducted in the campus canteens. The relatively small quantity of food waste can be linked to the implementation of a hybrid learning approach, which combines in-person and online learning for students.
