VIP Corals conducts virtual training on vulnerability of Ulva





The Batangas State University's Verde Island Passage Center for Oceanographic Research and Aquatic Life Sciences, together with the University of the Philippines - Diliman, Marine Science Institute, organized a virtual training for 6 coastal municipalities in Batangas Province on January 27-28, 2022.
