HIGHLIGHTS:

- BatStateU participates in Barakong Bayani Tree Planting planting 5,000 mangrove saplings. This is spearheaded by the Philippine Red Cross.
- The University has existing policy on procurement on local farmers and producers. In 2023, the policy on food security and nutrition policy has been reviewed.
- BatStateU researchers, in collaboration with researchers from other Universities and institutions, continuously works on biodiversity researchers focusing on flora and fauna and other ecosystems in different parts of Luzon island, Philippines.
- BatStateU celebrated the International Day of the Forest.
- Batangas State University-The National Engineering University, through its "Green Legacy Pledge," led environmental initiatives during Earth Month.
- The University plants 29,621 trees in 2023.
- In 2023, the University established 3 additional memoranda to reinforce the implementation of plastic reduction in the campus. Among these policies are OUP Memorandum Order No. 323 S. 2023 banning the use of tarpaulin for announcements and greetings, OUP Memorandum Order No. 374 S. 2023 Minimization of Single Use Plastic in the University Premises and Memorandum Order No. 313 S. 2023 Zero Waste Pablo Borbon every Friday of the week.
