- Batangas State university pay all its staff and faculty at least the living wage subject to existing laws, rules, and regulations, compensation must follow the principle that there should be "equal pay for substantially equal work and to base differences in pay upon substantive differences in duties and responsibilities, and qualification requirements of the positions" (Section 2 of Republic Act (RA) No. 6758).
- The university through Memorandum No. 330-b, s. 2021 was implementing laws, rules and regulations against forced labor and/or human trafficking in cognizance of Republic Act No. 9208 or the Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act as expanded by Republic Act No, 10364.
