### SOLAR POWER AND SAFETY EDUCATION: JIIEE BATSTATEU'S COMMUNITY PROJECT

The Junior Institute of Integrated Electrical Engineers (JIIEE) - BatStateU Chapter concluded the second phase of Project DICLAP, a community initiative aimed at empowering communities through leadership and partnership.

As part of the project, the JIIEE installed solar street lights in Barangay Wawa, providing the community with a sustainable and eco-friendly source of illumination. The solar lights were formally turned over to barangay officials, marking a significant step towards a brighter and more energy-efficient future for the community.



In collaboration with the Batangas City Bureau of Fire Protection, JIIEE also conducted electrical safety awareness activities. These included the BASICS seminar, which focused on basic electrical safety principles, and EESkwela ta, Mga Bata, a storytelling session using the ZAP Book to educate children about electrical safety.



The success of Project DICLAP Phase 2 was made possible through the cooperation of various stakeholders, including the Sangguniang Kabataan and barangay officials of Barangay Wawa, as well as other organizations and agencies.
